

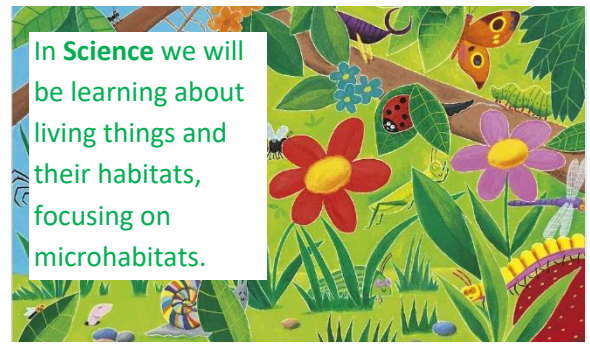
Year 2 Newsletter – Summer 2
