7. Headteacher's report

Governor's comments and questions.

a) In regard to pupil numbers are there any further children leaving and can we in future, see a reason on the report as to why the children are leaving?

We have a number of spaces across the school which has had an effect on our funding for this academic year. At the end of last year we lost 5 children out of year, 4 went to private schools and one moved out of area. Birth rates within Hertfordshire have dropped significantly in the last few years making. A category will be added to the Head Teachers Report for governors to easily see the reasons why children have left.

b) Are we affected by the miscalculation of numbers by the Civil Service?

Yes, but we are unsure by how much yet. This remains a challenge for the future.

c) The number of children with an EHCP has risen to six, what is the effect on the other children in the class?

This depends on the class and what the need is of the child with the EHCP. The children have additional support where needed, this allows as little disruption as possible to the rest of the class.

d) What do other schools do in terms of marketing?

Many local schools do not need to use marketing as they remain popular through reputation and word of mouth. This is the time of year that parents are applying to primary schools. The school does send follow up emails to parents that tour the school, this has resulted in some positive feedback.

e) When are the KS2 results added to the league tables?

The league tables were not produced last year, and no one has contacted the school so far, this academic year.

f) What are ALSA funding for?

ALSA are currently running 'Sponsor a Chair' and then the outside areas.

g) How does the school check that all parents have attended Parents' Evening?

The School Office do check that all parents have booked. The teachers do organise a meeting with parents if they cannot attend on the evening such as before pick or after drop off.
