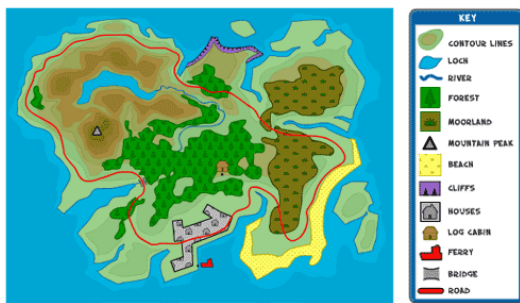
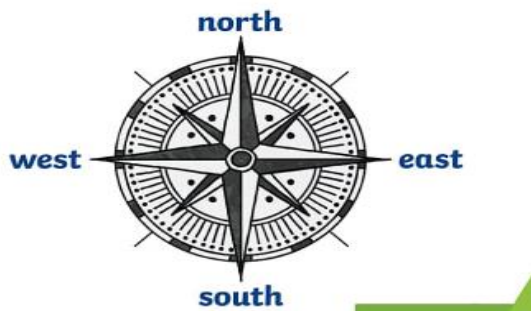

far	A long distance away
