<p>The main God is called Brahman</p> 	<p>God Brahma is the Creator, God Vishnu is the Preserver, and the God Shiva is the Destroyer.</p> 	<p>The Aum is the sound chanted during meditation. It is the name most suited for God. Written it looks like this:</p> 
<p>One person can take on different roles or jobs.</p>	<p>The same person might be a mother, a sister, a cousin, a daughter, a granddaughter, a neighbour, a charity worker and a teacher.</p>	
<p>soul</p>	<p>The spiritual part of a human being that is immortal (cannot die)</p>	
<p>The essence of a person</p>	<p>Who we are as a person - personal characteristics - brave, determined</p>	
<p>Atman</p>	<p>Hindus believe that a bit of Brahman called Atman is inside of them. Atman is 'eternal self'. It is often referred to as their 'spirit' or 'soul' and indicates their true self or essence which underpins who they are as people.</p>
